Dr Anil Kumar Singh is presently the Director and Head of the Department of Neurosciences at Fortis Hospital Noida. He joined Fortis after distinguished years of experience as the Director Professor and Head of the Department of Neurosurgery at Mulana Azad Medical College, New Delhi and G.B Pant Hospital, New Delhi.

Dr Singh is an innovative surgeon who is credited with introducing the widespread use of the microscope in modern neurosurgical practice thereby making it safe and Minimally Invasive. He has been credited to being the pioneer in the country for :

- Was the first in India to perform a successful Micro Vascular Decompression for Cranial Nerve Dysfunction (Trigeminal Neuralgia) due to Vascular Cross Compression.
- Was amongst the first to perform, independently, a successful Transoral Decompression (Adenoidectomy) for a Cranio Vertebral Junction Anomaly.
- Did the first (in India) Median Corpectomy for Cervical Spondylosis.
- Was amongst the first persons to start using spinal instrumentation.
- Was amongst the first persons to use the Extra Cavitory approach to the Dorsolumbar Region.
- Was amongst the first persons to implant an Artificial Cervical Disc (Bryan's disc).
- Was the first in India to start Direct Trans Nasal Trans Sphenoidal removal of Pituitary Tumors.
- Was amongst the first to start using Steffie's method for fixing Lumbar Spondylolisthesis.

Dr Singh is a Post Graduate in MS (General Surgery) and M.Ch (Neurosurgery). He also holds a Diploma from World Federation of Neurosurgical Societies (WFNS).

Dr Singh is a recipient of B.C. Roy award for excellence in Neurosurgery. He was also bestowed with the Lifetime Achievement award in the year 2001 by the Jhunjhunwala Trust. Dr A K Singh is the President of Delhi Neurological Association.
